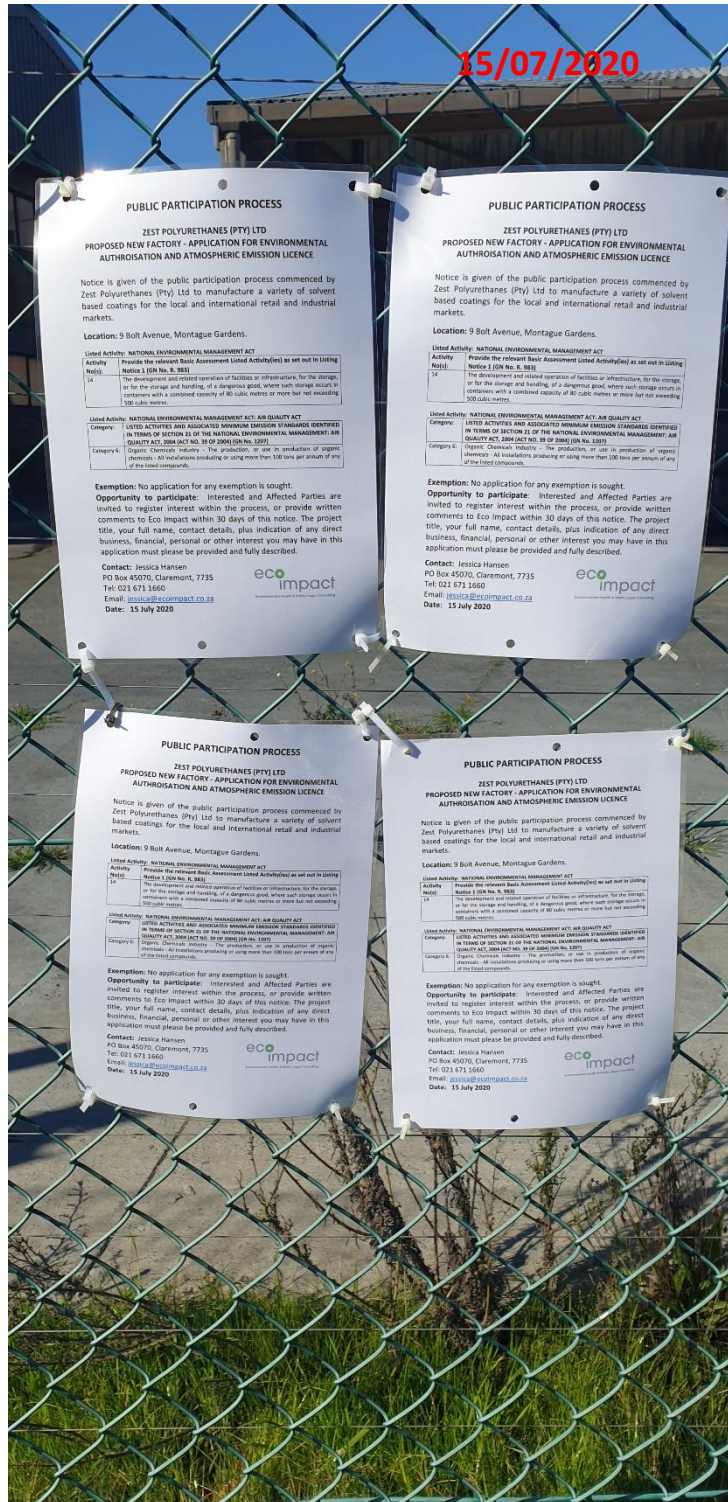

Giving something back

With the help of family, friends and the community, a resident of Voëlvlei in Kuils River recently got 46 food hampers together to distribute to others. “I was in a situation where I needed assistance too, then realised there are many more people in the same predicament,” says Estelle Geduld (50).

She is not part of any organisation and says she is just doing her own thing. She started in April and tries to prepare cooked food or soup thrice weekly to give out.

“I go to Happy Valley, Sarepta, Kalkfontein. Then I also drop off cooked food to homeless people.” She says there are three areas which she – normally accompanied by her husband or daughter, Jade Erasmus – will go to in the early evenings as the homeless are not there during the day.

Geduld’s donations come from individuals as she says big organisations are not willing to help because she is not registered. “I was also able to get a bit of assistance from OK, through Quinton Adams” (also known as The Shack Builder).

Her one big donor is a friend she has known from primary school days in Kuils River whose been living in Shanghai, China for close to 10 years – Tonye Langenhoven Stuurman.

“She helps with ingredients to cook on a weekly basis.”

Langenhoven Stuurman also helped with a donation of 200 face masks which they handed out earlier.

Geduld says she was very ill last year after she suffered a brain aneurysm. Her husband, Runay, a plumber by trade, had to stay home to look after her and financially things were tight. Now she says she wants to give something back.

“I live in an area called Voëlvlei, better known as The Pan. It is seen as an affluent part, but believe me, there is a need here too.”

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RECEIPT AND COMMENT ON THE NOTICE OF INTENT TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION IN TERMS OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT ACT, 1998 (ACT NO. 107 OF 1998) ("NEMA") ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT ("EIA") REGULATIONS, 2014 (AS AMENDED) AND THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN FOR THE PROPOSED REDEVELOPMENT OF A FACTORY AND ASSOCIATED INFRASTRUCTURE ON ERF 4912, MONTAGUE GARDENS.

Your Notice of Intent ("NOI") and Public Participation Plan dated and received by this Directorate via electronic mail correspondence on 26 June 2020, refer.

1. This letter serves as an acknowledgement of receipt of the abovementioned documents, by this Directorate and to provide comment on the NOI and Public Participation Plan.
2. *Landowner consent*

Given that the applicant is not the landowner of the proposed site, a duly dated and signed landowner consent form is required.

3. *Applicable listed activities*

- 3.1. Based on the information provided by you, your proposed development **will trigger** the following listed activity in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), namely:

Listing Notice 1 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended):

Activity Number: 14

Activity Description:

The development and related operation of facilities or infrastructure, for the storage, or for the storage and handling, of a dangerous good, where such storage occurs in containers with a combined capacity of 80 cubic metres or more but not exceeding 500 cubic metres.

- 3.2. A Basic Assessment process must be followed in order to apply for environmental authorisation. You are hereby advised that only those activities applied for will be considered for authorisation. The onus is on the applicant to ensure that all the applicable listed activities are applied for and assessed as part of the EIA process.

4. Screening Tool

- 4.1. Your attention is drawn to Government Notice No. 960 of 5 July 2019: Notice of the Requirement to Submit a Report Generated by the National Web Based Environmental Screening Tool in terms of Section 24(5)(h) of the NEMA and Regulation 16(1)(b)(v) of the EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended). Please note that the submission of a report generated from the National Web Based Environmental Screening Tool is compulsory as of 04 October 2019 when submitting an application for environmental authorisation in terms of Regulations 19 and 21 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended). You are advised to submit a screening report along with the pre-application Basic Assessment Report.
- 4.2. In addition, please note that the "Procedures for the Assessment and Minimum Criteria for Reporting on identified Environmental Themes in terms of Sections 24(5) (a) and (h) and 44 of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998, when applying for Environmental Authorisation" ("the Protocols") were published on 20 March 2020 (Government Notice No. 320 as published in Government Gazette No. 43110 on 20 March 2020) and came into effect on 09 May 2020. Protocols may therefore be applicable to your proposed development. According to the Protocols, before commencing with a specialist assessment, the current use of the land and environmental sensitivity of the site under consideration identified by the screening tool must be confirmed by undertaking site sensitivity verification. Further, a signed copy of the specific compliance statement for each applicable environmental theme must be appended to the Basic Assessment Report.

5. Content of a Basic Assessment Report ("BAR")

You are referred to Appendix 1 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) for the requirements with respect to the 'Content of basic assessment reports'.

6. You are advised that when undertaking the Basic Assessment process/ Scoping/EIR process, you must take into account all applicable guidelines, including the guidelines developed by the Department. These can be downloaded from the Department's website. In particular, the guidelines that may be applicable to the proposed development include, inter alia, the following:
- Circular EADP 0028/2014: One Environmental Management System.
 - Guideline for the Review of Specialist Input in the EIA process (June 2005).
 - Guideline for Environmental Management Plans (June 2005).
 - Guideline on Alternatives (March 2013).
 - Guideline on Need and Desirability (March 2013).
 - Other (as applicable).

7. Exemptions

The Directorate notes that you do not intend to apply for exemption from any provisions contained in the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) or the NEMA. Please note that should exemption from any provisions contained in the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) or the NEMA be required, an exemption application must be submitted and the exemption process must be finalised before submitting an application for Environmental Authorisation to the competent authority.

8. Alternatives

Be advised that in terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended) and the NEMA the investigation of alternatives is mandatory. All alternatives identified must therefore be investigated to determine if they are feasible and reasonable. In this regard it must be noted that the Department may grant authorisation for an alternative as if it has been applied for or may grant authorisation in respect of all or part of the activity applied for as specified in Regulation 20 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended). Alternatives are not limited to activity alternatives, but include layout alternatives, design, activity, operational and technology alternatives. Every EIA process must therefore identify and investigate alternatives, with feasible and reasonable alternatives to be comparatively assessed. If, however, after having identified and investigated alternatives, no feasible and reasonable alternatives were found, no comparative assessment of alternatives, beyond the comparative assessment of the preferred alternative and the "no-go" alternative, is required during the assessment. What would, however, be required in this instance is that proof of the investigation undertaken and motivation indicating that no reasonable or feasible alternatives other than the preferred and the "no-go" alternatives exist.

9. Public Participation

9.1. Please be advised that the requirements of the public participation process ("PPP") are specified in Regulation 41(2) of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended).

9.2. In light of the Directions issued by the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment on 05 June 2020 (Government Notice No. 650 of Government Gazette No. 43412), this Directorate notes that a Public Participation Plan (dated 24 June 2020) has been submitted.

9.2.1. The Public Participation Plan (dated 24 June 2020) indicates the following:

9.2.1.1. A notice board will be placed at the proposed site;

9.2.1.2. Written notice to the owners and occupiers of the land, including the ward councillor will be provided;

9.2.1.3. Two advertisements will be placed in a newspaper; and

9.2.1.4. Electronic mails with a link to download the pre-application BAR will be sent to Interested and Affected Parties.

9.2.2. Based on the information contained in the Public Participation Plan, this Department herewith provides the following comments:

9.2.2.1. The notification of the pre-application draft BAR must be posted to all I&APs who do not have access to electronic mail;

9.2.2.2. Reports must be submitted via email to the case officer, with attached pdf versions of the report or, if too large to attach to an email, to be made available via an electronic link provided in the email that is accessible by the Directorate. The Directorate may require that a hard copy of the reports also be submitted to the Department by a certain date, but will advise you accordingly;

9.2.2.3. A hard copy of the pre-application BAR should be made available upon reasonable request; and

9.2.2.4. Where there is a need for an alternative method of communication, it must be identified in consultation with the relevant party and relayed to the Department for approval.

9.2.3. You are hereby informed that this Department agrees to your methods of conducting the Public Participation Process as outlined in the abovementioned Public Participation Plan, provided that you also meet the requirements, as outlined above in paragraphs 9.2.2.1. to 9.2.2.4.

9.3. This Directorate notes that the pre-application BAR will be made available for a 30-day commenting period. Your attention is drawn to Section 4.4 of the Directions issued by the Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment on 05 June 2020 (Government Notice No. 650 of Government Gazette No. 43412). Should the 30-day extension be required, a Gantt chart must be submitted and agreed to prior to the implementation of the public participation plan. The BAR must be made available to the Interested and Affected Parties ("I&APs"), including all the relevant State Departments that administer laws relating to a matter affecting the environment, for comment for a period of 30 days. The applicant/EAP is required to inform this Directorate in writing upon submission of the report to the relevant State Departments.

9.4. In terms of good environmental practice you are encouraged to engage with State Departments and other Organs of State in the pre-application phase to solicit their inputs on any of their requirements to be addressed in the EIA process. Please note that this does not replace the requirement of making the BAR available to State Departments as stipulated above.

10. *Environmental Management Programme ("EMPr")*

In accordance with Section 24N of the NEMA and Regulation 19 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), the Department hereby requires the submission of an EMPr. The contents of such an EMPr must meet the requirements outlined in Section 24N (2) & (3) of the NEMA (as amended) and Appendix 4 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended). The EMPr must address the potential environmental impacts of the activity throughout the project life cycle including an auditing protocol for the assessment of the effectiveness of monitoring and management arrangements after implementation. The EMPr must be submitted together with the BAR.

11. *Need and Desirability*

In terms of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), when considering an application, this Directorate must take into account a number of specific considerations including, *inter alia*, the need for and desirability of any proposed development. As such, the need for and desirability of the proposed activity must be considered and reported on in the BAR. The BAR must reflect how the strategic context of the site in relation to the broader surrounding area, has been considered in addressing need and desirability.

12. *Climate change: Energy efficiency/water saving*

One of the objectives of the Western Cape Provincial Spatial Development Framework published by this Department is to minimise the consumption of scarce environmental resources such as water, fuel, building materials, mineral resources, electricity and land. To this effect and as part of the efforts to reduce the effects of climate change, you must, as part of the EIA process, identify energy efficient technologies (e.g. the use of low voltage or compact fluorescent lights instead of incandescent globes, maximising the use of solar heating, etc.) that could be implemented for the proposed development. Considering that South Africa is a water scarce country and that many catchments in the Western Cape are already water stressed, you must also consider implementing the use of water saving devices and technologies (e.g. dual flush toilets, low-flow shower heads and taps, etc.) for the proposed development.

13. *General*

13.1. In addition to the above requirements, you must clearly show how the proposed development complies with the principles contained in Section 2 of the NEMA and must also show how the proposed development meets the requirements of sustainable development.

13.2. You are hereby advised that the BAR must contain all the information outlined in Appendix 1 of the NEMA EIA Regulations, 2014 (as amended), and must also include the information requested in this letter. Omission of any of the said information may result in the refusal of Environmental Authorisation.

14. Please note that the pre-application consultation is an advisory process and does not pre-empt the outcome of any future application which may be submitted to the Department. No information provided, views expressed and/or comments made by officials during the pre-application consultation should in any way be seen as an indication or confirmation:

- that additional information or documents will not be requested; or
- of the outcome of the application.

15. Please be advised that for all future applications the latest template of the NOI application is dated November 2019 must be used.

16. This Department awaits the submission of the pre-application BAR and/or the application form for Environmental Authorisation.

Kindly quote the above-mentioned reference number in any future correspondence in respect of the pre-application.

Please note that the activity may not commence prior to obtaining an environmental authorisation from the competent authority. It is an offence in terms of Section 49A of the NEMA for a person to commence with a listed activity unless the Department has granted an Environmental Authorisation for the undertaking of the activity.

The Department reserves the right to revise its comments and request further information based on any information received.
