

## **STEPS TAKEN/TO BE TAKEN TO NOTIFY POTENTIALLY INTERESTED AND AFFECTED PARTIES**

This section of the report is included in compliance with the Regulations. Potential I&APs were/will be notified about the project by:

The notice informs them of any public meetings to be held, requests them to register as Interested and Affective Parties (I&APs) and invite them to provide written comments together with the reference number, their name, contact details and an indication of any direct business, financial, personal or other interest which they have in the application to the contact person indicated within 30 days from the date of the notice.
