forward in terms of the application based on the proposed application and current activities as the facility.

The directorate has provided the following comments and recommendations in their letter dated 17/04/2019:

#### **Background:**

The Department of Environmental Affairs and Development Planning, Sub-Directorate: Waste Management Licensing ('the Department') conducted a site visit on 13 September 2018 at the Brenn-O-Kem Facility after receiving an email regarding the storage of pressed material from wine cellars in silo bags on their property. The Facility arranged the site visit for the purpose of clarifying to the Department what the process entails and to seek advice on the authorisation(s) that would be required from a Waste Management perspective for the operation.

The company has been operating since 2000. The waste management activities started prior to the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008) (NEM:WA) being promulgated and the throughput capacity has not increased since, consequently the Facility did not need the Waste Management Licence (WML). During the site visit it was evident that the pressed material of wine cellars should be viewed as waste. The Facility receive the waste by trucks, bag the pressed material in silo bogs (50m and 100m in length) and store the bags separately from the Facility. The Facility distil the raw material to extract the alcohol and sell the alcohol to Distell Pty (Ltd). Tartaric acid and grape seed oil are also produced at the Facility. The residual material is used as fertiliser or animal feed. The Facility plan to upgrade their equipment to make the current distillation process more effective.

The Department was not aware that written comment was needed after the meeting, however, Ms. Lauren Abrahams from Eco Impact contacted the Department on 28 March 2019 to request such comment.

#### **Comments:**

- Upon expansion, the Facility could possibly trigger the waste management listed activities Category A 3(5)(6) (12) or Category B 4(3)(4)(10) of the NEM:WA 'List of Waste Management Activities that Have, or are Likely to Have, a Detrimental Effect on the Environment', published under Government Notice (GN) No. 921 of 29 November 2013, namely:

'3(5) The recovery of waste including the refining, utilisation or co-processing of waste in excess of 10 tons but less than 100 tons of general waste per day or in excess of 500kg but less than 1 ton of hazardous waste per day, excluding recovery that takes place as an integral part of an internal manufacturing process within the same premises.'

'3(6) The treatment of general waste using any form of treatment at a facility that has the capacity to process in excess of 10 tons but less than 100 tons.'

'3(12) The construction of a facility for a waste management activity listed in Category A of this Schedule (not in isolation to associated waste management activity).'

'4(3) The recovery of waste including the refining, utilisation, or co-processing of the waste at a facility that processes in excess of 100 tons of general waste per day or in

excess of 1 tons of hazardous waste per day, excluding recovery that takes place as an integral part of an internal manufacturing process within the same premises.'

'4(4) The treatment of hazardous waste in excess of 1 ton per day calculated as a monthly average, using any form of treatment excluding the treatment of effluent, wastewater or sewage.'

'4(10) The construction of a facility for a waste management activity listed in Category B of this Schedule (not in isolation to associated waste management activity).'

- The Facility currently triggers the waste management activity Category C 5(A) under the GN No. 921, namely:

### **Recommendations:**

The Department recommends the following:

- The Facility is required to comply with the NEM:WA 'National Norms and Standards for the Storage of Waste' (GN No. 926 of 29 November 2013) and register on the Department's Integrated Pollutant and Waste Information System (IPWIS), which can be accessed on the URL: <http://ipwis.pgwc.gov.zo/ipwis3/public/>.
- Once the Facility increases the throughput capacity, it must apply and obtain a WML prior to the planned increase in throughput capacity.
- The installation of new technology to optimize the percentage of alcohol that ore extracted from the current volumes of material will not be seen as being in furtherance of the listed activities that they will trigger upon expansion of the throughput capacity.

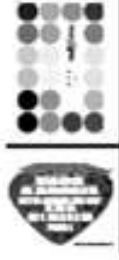
