#### **NOTIFICATION TO I&APS**

Potential I&AP's are notified about the project in the following manner (this is in compliance with Regulation 41 of GN R982):

1. Fixing notice boards at the boundary of the property in compliance with Regulation 41 of GN R982.

Site notices were erected on the **06 February 2018**. Notices were placed on either side of the MR 559 as indicated by the map included in the proof.

2. Written notifications are sent via registered post to potential I&APs (i.e. landowner, direct neighbours etc.) inviting them to register and give comments on the proposed development within 30 days from the date which appears on the notice. These notifications are in line with the requirements of the Regulations.

Four (4) notices were sent via registered mail on **09 February 2018** owners and occupiers of land adjacent to the site where the activity is undertaken. The notice requested them to register as Interested and Affective Parties (I&APs) and invited them to provide written comments together with the above reference number, their name, contact details and an indication of any direct business, financial, personal or other interest which they have in the application to the contact person indicated below within 30 days from the date of this notice. The notice also requested the owner to inform all persons residing on the property.

3. Placing an advertisement in a local newspaper the notice is in compliance with the Regulations.

An advertisement was placed in the Weslander on the **08 February 2018**.

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### PUBLIC MEETINGS, WORKSHOPS AND PRE-APPLICATION MEETINGS







No public meetings or workshops have been held thus far. The need for public meetings and workshops will be determined during the course of the public participation process as and if requested by I&APs and key departments.

### Issues Identified:

- Pipeline routes – the EAP must provide enough motivation as to the preferred pipeline route. This should include reasoning based on the existing crude oil pipeline among other factors.

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- Layout – the EAP must fully describe the layouts and motivate as to the Red site being the preferred site. The EAP must bring across why in the description the red site is the best alternative.
- Terms of reference for botanical assessment – indicate why botanist only assessed the Red site. Response why Rehab Plan was not included and whether it would be made available with the Revised EIAR.
- Geotechnical information – same for Blue and Red site.
- Loading arms vs flexible hoses and whether there is a preferred offloading alternative, or whether this will be dependent on the tender?
- The modification of the jetty would not result in any increase in the development footprint of the Port. No dredging is required and no impacts to the marine environment are anticipated.
- The Saldanha side of the jetty require additional “furniture”, but no marine impacts are anticipated.
- The development footprint must be clarified, and the botanical specialist must provide an updated statement on the correct development footprint and associated impacts.
- The number of tanks and preferred design must be indicated.
- Respond to the comments regarding the CSIR berthing study and whether it is required for the EIA decision-making.
- Confirmation that a MHI will be undertaken.
- An additional CD must be provided for DEA&DP: Coastal Management.

### **Conclusion:**

DEA&DP was satisfied that the EAP would be able to address all the issues raised in the comments provided by the Department on the 26 November 2018.

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### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION DURING THE FINAL SCOPING PHASE AND THE EIR PHASE**

Registered Interested and Affected Parties and key departments are afforded a 30 day comment period on the Draft Scoping Report. The comments are recorded and the EAP (specialists) respond to the comments and compile the comments and response report as part of the Final Scoping Report where after it is submitted to decision making authority (Department of Environmental Affairs) for acceptance or rejection.

Once the scoping report has been accepted by the DEA the public participation during the EIA phase involves submitting the draft EIR to the registered I&AP's and Key Departments for a 30 day period to comment on the findings of the report. Proof of the Public Participation Process conducted during the EIR phase will be included in the Final EIR. Once all comments have been received, the EIR will be finalised taking into account the comments received and thereafter submitted to the DEA for a final decision. A comments and responses report for the "Scoping Phase" will be included in the draft EIR, revised draft EIR and the Final EIR as **Appendix D3**. A comments and responses report for the "EIR Phase" will be included in the Revised Draft EIR as **Appendix D4**.

### **DECISION AND APPEAL PERIOD**

Once the DEA have reviewed the Final EIR and are satisfied that it contains sufficient information to make an informed decision, the DEA will use the information contained within the Final EIR to determine the environmental acceptability of the proponent's preferred options. A decision on the applications and associated reports will be made by the DEA based on the findings of the Final EIR.

Following the issuing of the decision, all key department and registered I&APs will be notified and afforded the opportunity to appeal the decision in terms of the NEMA.
