

## **SUMMARY OF THE PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PROCESS FOLLOWED TO DATE**

### **Notification to I&APs**

Potential I&AP's are notified about the project in the following manner (this is in compliance with Regulation 41 of GN R982):

- Fixing notice boards at the boundary of the property in compliance with Regulation 41 of GN R982.
- Written notifications are sent via registered post to potential I&APs (i.e. landowner, direct neighbours etc.) inviting them to register and give comments on the proposed development within 30 days from the date which appears on the notice. These notifications are in line with the requirements of the Regulations.
- Placing an advertisement in a local newspaper the notice is in compliance with the Regulations.

All potential I&APs are afforded the opportunity (within a 30 day period) to register for the project. All registered I&APs will be informed of further activities regarding the project.

### **Public Meetings, Workshops and Pre-application Meetings**

No public meetings, workshops and pre-application meetings have been held thus far. The need for public meetings, workshops and pre-application meetings will be determined during the course of the public participation process as and if requested by I&APs and key departments.

### **Availability of the Draft Scoping Report**

As per the requirements of Regulation 43 of GN R982, the Draft Scoping Report will be made available to all relevant key departments and all registered I&APs for a further 30 day commenting period.

The Draft Scoping Report will be included for statutory comment with the written notice as sent to the commenting organs of state for a 30 day commenting period. Electronic copies (CDs) will also be made available to any department or I&AP on request and on our website at [www.ecoimpact.co.za](http://www.ecoimpact.co.za).

Proof of postage/delivery will be included in the final Scoping Report.

Comments received will be responded to in the final Scoping Report as per the requirements of regulations. And the comments and response report as well as proof of all comments received will be included in the Final Scoping Report.

### **Public Participation during the Final Scoping Phase and the EIR Phase**

Registered Interested and Affected Parties and key departments are afforded a 30 day comment period on the Draft Scoping Report. The comments are recorded and the EAP (specialists) respond to the comments and compile the comments and response report as part of the Final Scoping Report where after it is submitted to decision making authority (Department of Environmental Affairs) for acceptance or rejection.

Once the scoping report has been accepted by the DEA the public participation during the EIA phase involves submitting the draft EIR to the registered I&AP's and Key Departments for a 30 day period

to comment on the findings of the report. Proof of the Public Participation Process conducted during the EIR phase will be included in the Final EIR. Once all comments have been received, the EIR will be finalised taking into account the comments received and thereafter submitted to the DEA for a final decision.

### **Decision and Appeal Period**

Once the DEA have reviewed the Final EIR and are satisfied that it contains sufficient information to make an informed decision, the DEA will use the information contained within the Final EIR to determine the environmental acceptability of the proponent's preferred options. A decision on the applications and associated reports will be made by the DEA based on the findings of the Final EIR.

Following the issuing of the decision, all key department and registered I&APs will be notified and afforded the opportunity to appeal the decision in terms of the NEMA.

Notice is given of the Public Participation Process (PPP) commenced by the Strategic Fuel Fund - Saldanha (SFF Association - Incorporated under Section 21) a subsidiary of the Central Energy Fund (CEF). SFF proposes the development of an 8.3 km LPG (Liquid Petroleum Gas) pipeline, with an internal diameter of 12 inches, will run within an existing servitude from the SFF Saldanha tank farm (Erf 1038) to the Saldanha Jetty (Erf 1185). Six additional LPG bullets are proposed at the Saldanha tank farm (Erf 1038) providing 8000 tons of additional capacity for the facility.
