The expansion of the abattoir and rendering facility. The rendering facility will be expanded by the installation of three additional 5.5ton cookers inside the existing rendering facility building. The two 5 ton John Thompson (existing boilers) will, be replaced with two 10 ton John Thompson Boilers inside the existing boiler room. No expansions to the associated infrastructure (effluent treatment facility, etc.) are needed.

The existing abattoir will be expanded in order to increase the number of chickens to be slaughtered to 460 000 chickens per day. In order to increase the number of chickens to be slaughtered, the following expansions is needed to the existing infrastructure:

- A new dispatch area of $(\pm 1680\text{m2})$ roof area
- A new dispatch concrete apron area (± 2838m2)
- New gravel road 7.4m wide (± 1500m2)
- New 4 ton Gyro Freezers (\pm 421m2)
- New life bird receiving area consisting of a buffer and processing area of (\pm 3048m2). This area is in between the existing abattoir and rendering facility
- New change room extensions (± 254 m2)
- New truck holding area (± 375m2)
- New truck driveways and turning area (± 1860m2), and
- New weighbridge (23m x 3m) and control room (5m x 3m)

The above infrastructure and extensions will all happen next to the existing abattoir and rendering facility on the area that is zoned Agri-Industrial.
